

APPLICATION PROCEDURE & TIMELINE FOR STUDENTS APPLYING TO THE TRADITIONAL BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN NURSING PROGRAM

STUDENTS APPLYING TO THE TRADITIONAL PRELICENSURE B.S.N. PROGRAM

All prelicensure nursing applicants will apply for admission using NursingCAS, the centralized application system for nursing programs. Applicants will be required to pay an application fee of \$60 to NursingCAS. November 1	Fall application opens in NursingCAS
April 1	Fall application deadline
May 15	Notification of admission decision to fall applicants
June 15	Deadline to accept offer of admission to the fall cohort
July 15	Final materials deadline for all requirements to be met and final transcripts received for students starting the Traditional B.S.N. program in the fall semester. Requirements include successful completion of all prerequisite courses and meeting all compliance requirements.
May 1	Spring application opens in NursingCAS
October 1	Application deadline for spring applicants
November 15	Notification of admission decision to spring applicants
December 16	Deadline to accept offer of admission to the spring cohort

Final materials deadline for all requirements to be met and final transcripts received for students starting the Traditional B.S.N. program in the spring semester. Requirements include the completion of all prerequisite courses and compliance documentation.
